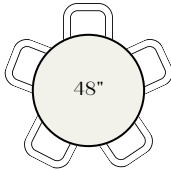


We generally recommend allowing 24 inches of space per person seated at your table and allow a minimum of 2" (tight) to 6"+ (roomy) between chairs.

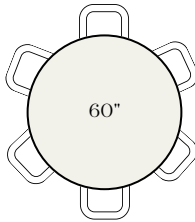

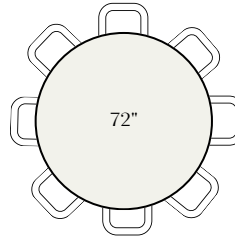

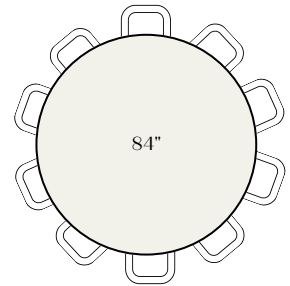

The equations to determine how many chairs can fit around your round table is to multiply the table top diameter by 3.14, then divide by 24" for cozy seating, or 30" for comfortable seating.

CARE

- Avoid direct sunlight and heat.
- Keep humidity levels consistent at 40-45%.
- Dust regularly with a microfiber cloth following the grain pattern of the wood.
- Clean with a damp cloth and dry immediately.
- Use tablecloths, placemats, and coasters.
- Avoid placing or scraping sharp objects on the surface.
- Avoid aerosol polishers and anything containing silicon.
